

Show Rules

Competitors - please remember that this is our home and we request you respect and look after it.

- 1. Insurance: it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to insure all property and livestock on the showground or elsewhere which is his own, or for which he is responsible, including public liability insurance.
- 2. Dogs are permitted on the showground but must be kept on a lead at all times. Please clean up after your dog. Note: No dogs allowed in any Arena/Collecting Ring. Dog walking is NOT allowed over any private property.
- 3. Please do not muck your trailer or horsebox out on the showground. Please clear up all droppings around your trailer/ horsebox area along with any hay or any other litter. There are bins around the site.
- 4. No horse should be left unattended. DO NOT tie up outside your trailer/ horse box.
- 5. No sitting/standing on any fencing. DO NOT allow your horse/pony to chew any fencing
- 6. The show organizers have taken all responsible precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring. The show organizers will not be liable for any claim in respect of damage, loss, injury or accident, to any person, horse or property however caused. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant has read and understood these terms and conditions.
- 7. Entry fees are non-refundable. If the show has to be cancelled for any reason, then every provision will be made to re-schedule. Pre entry only refundable if a Vet's Certificate is provided.
- 8. The Judge's decision is final.
- 9. Hard hats to current BS EN 1384, PAS 015 or ASTM F1163 must be worn & correctly secured whilst mounted. Riding Boots must be worn when mounted.
- 10. In the event of any rider travelling to a show on their own, details of a contact should be left with the secretary in case of an accident.
- 11. It is a condition of entry that ALL competitors and associates agree to abide by the rules of Topthorn Arena. It is a condition of site entry that Topthorn's First Aiders are able to attend to any person in case of injury/emergency.
- 12. All children under the age of 16 must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times.
- 13. All horses competing at Topthorn Arena should be up to date with the BEF recommended vaccination schedule.
- 14. No-one is allowed onto the yards or paddocks of Millbank Livery without prior consent as this is private property.
